The bidder can also submit the acknowledgement of their application submitted to MNRE for enlistment in the ALMM under this bid. Enlistment in the ALMM is a mandatory pre-requisite to enter into agreement with CREDA under this bid. In case of multiple distributor/dealer of a manufacturer participates in the tender then the tender of all dealers/distributors including manufacturer shall be rejected.	<b>Registration of Bidder –</b> Bidders shall have to register as vendor for Solar PV Modules in CREDA in SPV Programme for FY 2021-22 before execution of agreement (in Annexure – I) under this bid. Only one authorized dealer/distributor of a manufacturer on behalf of manufacturer itself shall be allowed to participate in the tender. Page no. 16/ Clause no. 30	<p><b>DECLARATION OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST –</b></p> <p>The bidder hereby declares that nobody connected with or in the employment of <b>CREDA</b> is not/shall not ever be admitted as partner in the contract.</p>	<p><b>DECLARATION OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST –</b></p> <p>1. The bidder shall not be permitted to Bid for the work if the section of HO CREDA (responsible for implementation of work) in which his near relative is posted. Furthermore, the successful bidder shall not be given work in the district in which his near relative is posted. The bidder shall also intimate the names of his near relatives working in the CREDA. Bidder shall also intimate the name of persons who are working with him in any capacity and who are near relatives to any employee in CREDA. Any breach of this condition by the bidder would render himself liable to be blacklisted for three years and removed from approved list of vendors.</p> <p><b>Note:-</b> By the term near relatives is meant Wife, Husband, Parents and son , Brother, Sister, Brother-in-law, Father-in-law, Mother-in-law etc.</p> <p>2.
