RULES AND REGULATIONS OF Chhattisgarh State Renewable Energy Development Agency (CREDA)

INTRODUCTION

- a) The name of the Agency shall be Chhattisgarh State Renewable Energy Development Agency (CREDA)
In Hindi : “छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य अक्षय ऊर्जा विकास अभिकरण”
- b) Office:- the registered office of the Agency shall be situated at Raipur. Chhattisgarh.

DEFINITION

In these rules and regulations, unless the context requires,

- a) Agency shall mean Chhattisgarh State Renewable Energy Development Agency. (CREDA)
- b) Chairman shall mean the Chairman of the Agency.
- c) Chief Executive shall mean the Chief Executive of the Agency

MEMBERS

The Agency shall consist of the following members; -

- a) First members of the Governing Body and those who have subscribed to the Memorandum of Association.
- b) Members nominated by the Department of Energy, Govt. of Chhattisgarh.

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE GOVERNING BODY

The general superintendence, direction and control of the affairs of the Agency shall be vested in the Governing Body of the Agency. Save as herein expressly provided all the duties powers, functions and rights whatsoever or consequential and incidental to the carrying out of the objectives of the Agency shall be exercised by the Governing Body. The Governing Body shall be bound to carry out any direction that the State Government gives from time to time.

In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions and subject to the provisions of Memorandum, the Governing Body may: -

- {a} make, amend or repeal any Bylaw relating to the administration and management of the affairs of the Agency subject to the observance of the provisions contained In the registration of Societies Act 1973.

- {b} receive grants and contributions and have custody of the funds of the Agency.
- {c} prepare the budget estimates of the Agency for each year and sanction the expenditure within the limits of the budget.
- {d} prescribe and conduct courses of study, training, seminar and research in power, renewable energy technology on its own or through an institution set up by it or affiliated to it.
- {e} prescribe rules and regulations for the various courses of training in power and renewable energy, technology to be imparted by it or any agency affiliated to it.
- {f} lay down standard of efficiency to be demonstrated before the award or merit certificate and distinctions in respect of training courses that may be conducted by the Agency or institutions set up by it or affiliated to it.
- {g} institute and award fellowship, prizes and medals.
- {h} cooperate with any other organisations in the matter of training, research, finance and other aspects relating to use of energy and development of alternative energy resources.
- {i} enter into agreements for and on behalf of the Agency.
- {j} institute and defend all legal proceedings on behalf of the Agency.
- {k} appoint committees for the disposal of any business of the Agency or for tendering advice in any matter pertaining to the Agency.
- {l} delegate to such extent as it may deem necessary its powers to any officer or committee of the Governing Body.
- {m} consider and approve the annual reports, audit reports, annual accounts and the financial estimates of the Agency.
- {n} make, adopt, amend, vary or rescind from time to time Bylaw (a) for conduct of the business of Governing Body and the committees to be appointed by it (b) for delegation of its powers and (c) for such other matters as it may deem necessary.
- {o} perform such additional functions and carry out such duties as may from time to time be assigned to it by State Govt. in the Deptt. of Energy.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the CHHATTISGARH STATE RENEWABLE ENERGY DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CREDA), is to promote the research, development and popularisation of Non conventional & renewable sources of energy.

In particular, the objectives are :

- a) To identify small canal heads and drops, in streams and there after generate power through Mini/Micro Hydel projects with a view to augmenting the energy sources of the state and for making power available in the rural areas.
- b) To identify, formulate proposals and set up units (including demonstration) of all non-conventional & renewable energy devices specifically to encourage, develop and extend the use of-
 - i) Bio-energy including energy plantations.
 - ii) Devices for utilising wind energy.
 - iii) Devices for utilising solar energy including photovoltaic systems.
 - iv) Devices for utilising Geothermal energy.
- c) To undertake or sponsor studies on renewable and non-conventional energy generation, distribution and utilisation including its environmental effects, socio-economic feasibility, cost benefit analysis and techno-economic feasibility.
- d) To formulate and implement a broad based energy conservation programme and a programme for future energy use.
- e) To take special steps to train and encourage young scientists and technologists working in the field of energy resources and plan for their proper involvement in the development of alternate and renewable energy sources.
- f) To establish and maintain a technical library and information center for collecting, collating and dissemination information on renewable energy resources.
- g) To undertake all such other things as may be incidentally conducive to the attainment of the above objectives.
